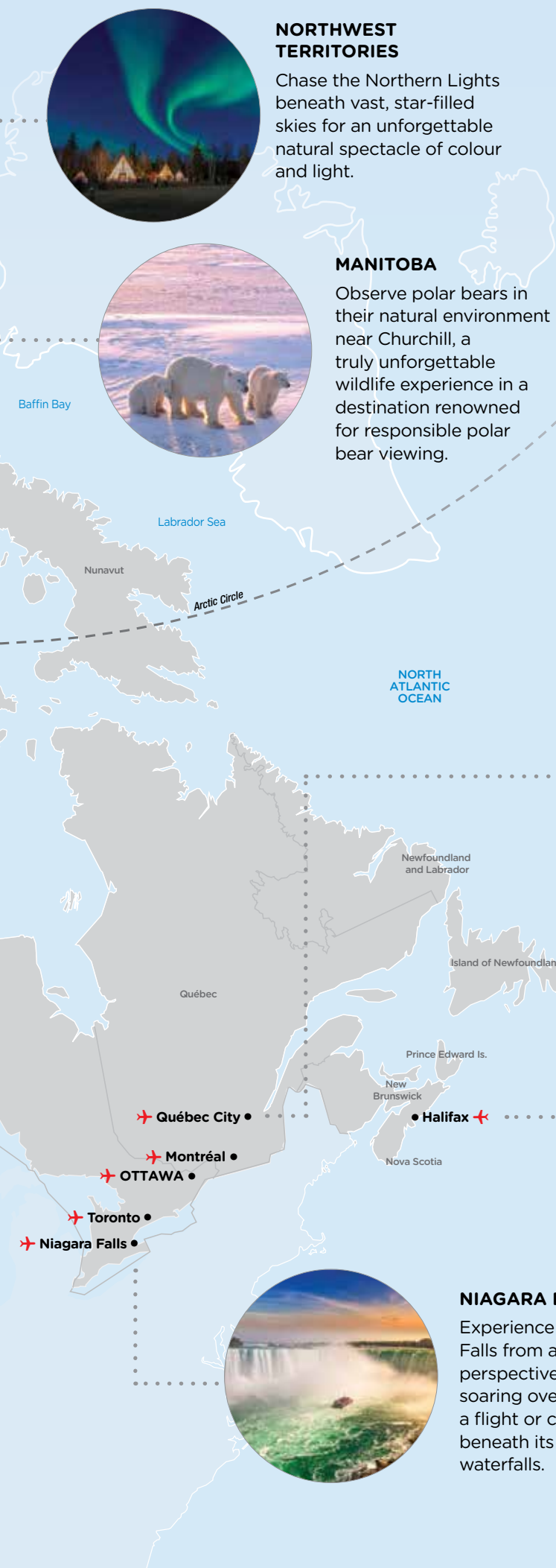

HELPFUL TIPS

Canada and Alaska are wonderful places to visit all year round. Before you begin your trip, make sure to read our helpful travel information, to make the most of your time in Vancouver, Anchorage and beyond.

WHEN TO GO

Canada and Alaska have varied climates. Summer (June – August) brings long, warm days, with up to 22 hours of daylight in Alaska whereas Autumn (September – November) sees cooler temperatures, colourful foliage and early snowfall.

Winter (December – February) is cold with snowfall, especially in Alaska and with limited daylight, it's prime time for viewing the Northern Lights. Over time, Spring (March – May) brings longer days, rising temperatures, melting snow and blooming wildflowers.



Currency

Canada: Canadian Dollar (CAD).
Alaska: US Dollar (USD).



Language

French in Québec, with English widely spoken.



Time Zone

12.5 – 19 hours behind Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST). Daylight Saving Time is observed from March to November.



Electricity

An international adaptor is required. Type A, low voltage 120V/60Hz.



PLAN AHEAD

- Be mindful when packing; you may need to lift luggage on and off trains and comply with baggage limits on small regional flights.
- High demand and limited availability in Alaska's short travel season mean accommodation and touring book out quickly. Make sure to secure your arrangements early to avoid missing out on key experiences.

ITINERARY TIPS

- Dangerous animals such as bears, moose and wolves can be encountered in Canada's forested areas. Be aware of your surroundings, keep a safe distance, and never approach or feed wildlife.
- Winter temperatures in Canada and Alaska can drop well below -20°C , especially in remote regions. Make sure to dress in insulated layers, protect exposed skin, and plan ahead for extreme cold conditions.

VISAS & PASSPORTS

All travellers to Canada and Alaska must carry a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of departure from Australia. All travellers to Canada are required to obtain the Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) prior to travel. All travellers to Alaska are required to obtain the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) prior to travel. As visa information can change at any time, we recommend you seek advice regarding passports, visas, and other travel requirements at smartraveller.gov.au

TIPPING

Tipping is expected in restaurants, bars and taxis. As a guide expect to pay 15% to 20% of the bill, CAD1/USD1 per bag for hotel porters and 10% of the tour price for tour guides.

DRIVING TIPS

- All cars are left hand drive but remember to drive on the right side of the road!
- Distances between towns can be long, so refuel whenever possible and don't let your tank run low.
- Moose, caribou, bison and bears are common, particularly at dawn and dusk. Slow down, stay alert and be prepared to stop suddenly.
- Drive to conditions, not speed limits. Posted limits assume dry roads. Reduce speed in rain, snow or gravel sections and allow extra stopping distance.

DEPARTS: Daily (31 May - 31 Aug 27)

Day 1: Anchorage Arrive at Anchorage Airport and collect your car rental. The remainder of the day is yours to discover Anchorage and its surrounding beauty.

Day 2: Anchorage Spend the day exploring this modern city and its surroundings. Visit the Chugach National Forest or you may decide to have a relaxing day in town.

Day 3: Anchorage to Nabesna Travel through spectacular landscapes featuring the Chugach Mountains, scenic valleys and the magnificent Matanuska Glacier. At your destination, discover pristine wilderness, glacial rivers and a rustic homestead.

Day 4: Nabesna to Dawson City Journey towards Tok and cross the border into Canada through some of North America's most untouched wilderness. Arrive in historic Dawson City, the riverside heart of the Klondike Gold Rush.

Day 5: Dawson City Spend time exploring this historic city. Many original buildings have stood the test of time, while others have been faithfully restored to either their original grandeur, or rustic ruggedness. Take the day to tour the historic landmarks of Dawson City and visit the surrounding goldfields.

Day 6: Dawson City to Whitehorse Travel the Klondike Highway south to Whitehorse through the scenic wilderness of the Yukon.

Day 7: Whitehorse Journey along the South Klondike Highway before boarding the historic White Pass & Yukon Route Railway through spectacular mountain scenery to Skagway, Alaska, returning to Whitehorse by coach.

Day 8: Whitehorse to Haines Junction Head west through the small villages of the territory to Haines Junction, situated on the edge of the massive Kluane National Park.

Day 9: Haines Junction Today is a good opportunity to explore the village. Perhaps pay a visit to the Champagne and Aishihik First Nations' Da Kų Cultural Centre, an interactive living museum that celebrates the history, culture and art of the Indigenous people of the area.

Day 10: Haines Junction to Tok A breathtaking journey along the Alaska Highway, rugged mountain ranges, dense forests, and pristine lakes. As you approach Tok, you may spot some wildlife such as bears, moose, and eagles.

Day 11: Tok to Fairbanks Drive along Alaska Highway and notice the landscape slowly transitioning from flat and rolling hills to mountain views and river crossings.

Day 12: Fairbanks to Denali National Park Travel the George Parks Highway, across the Tanana River. Driving south, you will soon see Mount McKinley, North America's tallest peak at 6193m that marks the entrance into Denali National Park.

Day 13: Denali National Park Today independently explore some of the many day hike trails in Denali National Park. The protected parklands stretch out serenely beneath the shadows of the majestic Mount McKinley, giving visitors the opportunity to see moose, caribou, grizzly bears and Dall sheep.

Day 14: Denali National Park to Anchorage Travel south through the stunning wilderness before arriving in Anchorage.

Day 15: Anchorage Return your car hire at the airport where your tour concludes.



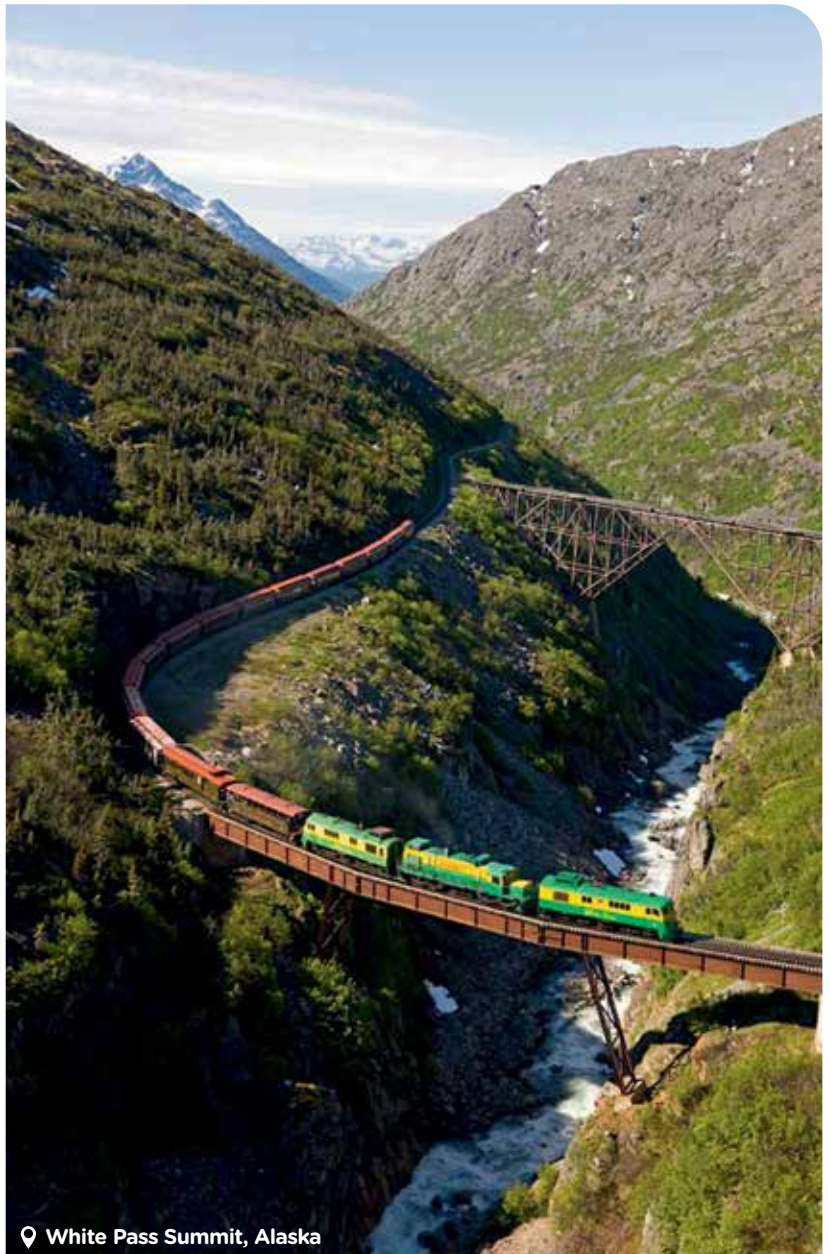

Day 1: Toronto to Kangerlussuaq, Greenland Your journey begins with an early morning charter flight from Toronto to Kangerlussuaq, where expansive tundra, rugged mountains and pristine Arctic landscapes provide a spectacular welcome to Greenland.

Days 2-3: Sisimiut Discover West Greenland's complex coastal waterways, featuring small communities, glaciers, islands and fjords set against a backdrop of towering mountains.

Day 4: Ilulissat Experience the spectacular Ilulissat Icefjord, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where giant icebergs drift from the Sermeq Kujalleq Glacier into the North Atlantic. Visit the Icefjord Centre, wander through town and cruise among these magnificent icy giants.

Day 5: Western Greenland Explore Greenland's remote west coast by ship and Zodiac, with shore excursions guided by local experts. Enjoy tundra walks, learn about Inuit culture and wildlife, and take in the breathtaking Arctic scenery.

Day 6: At Sea, Davis Strait Sail toward Nunavut, the expedition team will deepen your understanding of the Arctic.

Days 7-9: Lancaster Sound & Devon Island Cruise through the wildlife-rich waters of Lancaster Sound, home to narwhal, beluga and bowhead whales, as well as a variety of Arctic seabirds. Travel by ship and Zodiac while learning about the region's importance to Inuit communities. View the striking

landscapes of Devon Island, and visit the world's largest uninhabited island, on guided hikes through tundra and glacial valleys.

Day 10: Beechey Island Visit historic Beechey Island, the site of Sir John Franklin's 1845 expedition. View the graves and remnants of early Arctic exploration while learning about the quest for the Northwest Passage.

Day 11: Bellot Strait Navigate the narrow waters of Bellot Strait, where the eastern and western Arctic meet at the northernmost point of continental North America.

Days 12-15: Kitikmeot Region Sail through the heart of the Northwest Passage, where vast Arctic landscapes, sea ice and abundant wildlife define the journey. Learn about the region's rich exploration history, including Roald Amundsen's legendary transit, while taking in the ever-changing scenery of Canada's High Arctic.

Day 16: Cambridge Bay Visit this welcoming community on Victoria Island and gain insight into life in the Canadian Arctic. Learn about the region's culture and traditions, visit the Canadian High Arctic Research Station and browse locally made crafts.

Day 17: Kugluktuk to Yellowknife Today marks the end of the journey as we disembark and fly by charter to Yellowknife, Northwest Territories.

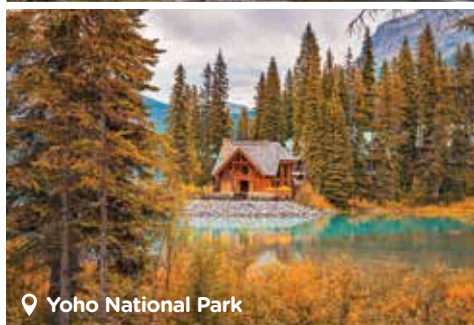

WESTERN CANADA NATIONAL PARKS 7 DAYS

📍 SEATTLE - KAMLOOPS - BANFF - LAKE LOUISE - JASPER - CLEARWATER - WHISTLER - SEATTLE

DEPARTS: 13, 27 Jun, 11, 25 Jul, 8, 22 Aug 27

Day 1: Seattle to Kamloops Journey through Kamloops, where the North and South Thompson rivers meet. Kamloops is abundant with stunning scenery and great wildlife viewing. Cougars, bears, elk and more inhabit the Thomson River Valley. En route stop for a short walk and picnic at Bridal Veil Falls Provincial Park.

Day 2: Kamloops to Banff Travel to Yoho National Park and explore Emerald Lake. Walk the lakeshore or relax with the views. Continue across Kicking Horse Pass and the Continental Divide into Alberta, enjoying vistas on Rogers Pass.

Day 3: Banff to Lake Louise Journey to Lake Louise. Hike to Lake Agnes Tea House or Plain of Six Glaciers, canoe, or stroll the lakeshore. Visit Moraine Lake in the Valley of the Ten Peaks.

Day 4: Lake Louise to Jasper Spend the day exploring the Icefields Parkway. This drive offers endless vistas, jagged mountains, glaciers and wildlife viewing opportunities. Enjoy short walks and views of Bow Glacier and Peyto Lake.

Day 5: Jasper to Clearwater Enjoy a leisurely morning in Jasper with alpine lakes, wildlife, and trails. Optional activities include hiking, biking, or visiting local viewpoints. In the afternoon, travel the Yellowhead Highway, passing Mount Robson.

Day 6: Clearwater to Whistler Travel to the alpine resort of Whistler. Today is free to enjoy spectacular scenery and incredible photo opportunities as you explore this ski town, home of the 2010 Winter Olympics.
